ZURICH

- Fraumünster Church The church was built from the middle of the 9th century on the opposite side of the river to the Grossmunster. Today, many visitors are attracted by the five stained glass windows prepared by Marc Chagall in the 1960's as well as by the rosette in the south transept.
- Bahnhofstrasse Bahnhofstrasse is Zurich's main downtown street and one of the world's most expensive and exclusive shopping avenues. In 2011, a study named the Bahnhofstrasse the most expensive street for retail property in Europe, and the third most expensive worldwide. In 2016 ranked ninth.

LUCERNE

- Lion Monument The Lion Monument, or the Lion of Lucerne, is a sculpture in Lucerne, Switzerland, designed by Bertel Thorvaldsen and hewn in 1820–21 by Lukas Ahorn. It commemorates the Swiss Guards who were massacred in 1792 during the French Revolution, when revolutionaries stormed the Tuileries Palace in Paris, France. Mark Twain praised the sculpture of a mortally-wounded lion as "the most mournful and moving piece of stone in the world."
- Wooden Chapel Bridge The Kapellbrücke (literally, Chapel Bridge) is a covered wooden footbridge spanning diagonally across the Reuss River in the city of Lucerne in central Switzerland. Named after the nearby St. Peter's Chapel, the bridge is unique since it contains a number of interior paintings dating back to the 17th century, although many of them were destroyed along with most of the centuries old bridge in a 1993 fire. Subsequently restored, the Kapellbrücke is the oldest wooden covered bridge in Europe, as well as the world's oldest surviving truss bridge. It serves as the city's symbol and as one of Switzerland's main tourist attractions

INTERLAKEN

Luzern - Interlaken Express - The panoramic journey between Lucerne and Interlaken could offers comfort and magnificent views through modern panoramic windows. En-route, you'll admire the breathtaking Alpine panorama, sparkling lakes and idyllic countryside.

SCHILTHORN

- Lauterbrunnen Valley The Staubbach Falls, arguably the most renowned among the 72 waterfalls in Lauterbrunnen Valley, holds the title of the third highest waterfall, with a height of 297 meters
- Schilthorn situated above the charming village of Mürren and the Lauterbrunnen Valley. Standing at 2,970 meters above sea level, it offers breathtaking 360-degree views of over 200 mountain peaks. The summit also hosts the Piz Gloria revolving restaurant. The Schilthorn became famous as a location for the 1969 James Bond film "On Her Majesty's Secret Service".
- Piz Gloria Observation Deck Enjoy the Earth's most breathtaking views of Monch, Eiger, and Jungfrau (UNESCO World Heritage) are visible, extending to the Jura Mountains, Mt. Titlis, Germany's Black Forest, sometimes even Mont Blanc. Additionally, the beautiful lakes of Brienz and Thun can be
- Skyline Walk The Skyline Walk is constructed of steel and reinforced glass, located at the Birg middle station lets you stare into the abyss below to take in the sights of the Alps and the mountain peaks
- Thrill Walk is a breathtaking 200 meter long structure made of steel, glass and mesh which leads down into the perpendicular walls of the imposing rock massif. The steel structure clings to the rock before swerving under the observation deck and cableway to end below the cable car station. Features including a crawl-through tunnel, glass-bottomed floor, rope and cattle grid lend an additional frisson of thrill to this spine-tingling adventure.
- 360° Restaurant Piz Gloria its own axis in 45 minutes, is the first revolving restaurant in the Alps. Piz Gloria Restaurant offers the best views of the magnificent peaks, Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau and the food is just as spectacular!

ISELTWALD

Lake Brienz - One of Switzerland's most beautiful and deep lakes is called Lake Brienz. It's recognised for its bizarre turquoise colour, which draws a slew of tourists to its coastlines. South Korean television show "Crash Landing on You" is hugely popular and has won over audiences all over the world. The usage of Switzerland's stunning scenery and scenic sites plays a significant role in the show's visual appeal and narrative. One of the most popular scenes in CLOY among viewers was in episode 3, when Jeong-hyeok reminisces about his time alone playing the piano on this wooden "stage" on Lake Brienz. Se-ri also happened to hear him playing while boating on the same lake during a significant time in her life. Iseltwald and Lake Brienz are therefore connected in the programme.

BERN

Bear Pit – The Bern Bear Park is a unique recreation area at the lower end of the old town of Bern. It is open around the clock and free for all visitors. Brown bears have been living in this generously-sized enclosure on the banks of the river Aare since 2009.

GRUYÈRES

- La Maison du Gruyère is a village cheese dairy providing the opportunity of viewing the hand-made production of the cheese "Le Gruyère AOP".
- Gruyères Castle Built-in the late 13th Century, Perched atop a small hill with the mighty Swiss Alps in the background. A Swiss heritage site today, it is home to an art museum with paintings by notable artists like Jean-Baptiste-Camille Corot, Barthélemy Menn, and many others. A number of temporary exhibitions, cultural events, and music festivals are also regularly organized at its premises. Walk along the outside rampart which goes to the back of the château. The back has some beautiful French gardens and views of the surrounding town.

MONTREUX

 Chillon Castle – An island castle located on Lake Geneva, south of Veytaux in the canton of Vaud. Successively occupied by the house of Savoy then by the Bernese from 1536 until 1798, it now belongs to the State of Vaud and is classified as a Swiss Cultural Property of National Significance.

GENEVA

- Lake Geneva Jet d'Eau Water Fountain one of the tallest fountain in the world. The fountain
 presence gives the power to the place and its majesty serves as a reminder that the area is a
 powerful and well organized country.
- Flower Clock The clock, which is located in a corner of the Jardin Anglais, was first erected in 1955 and contains over 12,000 flowers and plants. The flower arrangements change with the seasons. The Swiss-accurate time displayed on the floral clock is transmitted by satellite, so it is not only beautiful but also functions as a timepiece. Another significant aspect is that the seconds hand is the longest in the world at 2.5 metres long!

CHAMONIX

Ride Aiguille Du Midi Cable Car to view Mont Blanc – Getting a breathtaking view of Mont Blanc by taking the Aiguille du Midi cable car from Chamonix's center to the mountain's top slopes at a height of 3,842 meters. It is France's highest cable car. It's an opportunity to explore the high mountains in perfect safety. Enjoy distinctive sights like the Espace Vertical, the tallest climbing museum ever constructed, at the summit of the Aiguille du Midi. Or the Espace Mont-Blanc, which is well-protected by huge picture windows and offers views of the surrounding mountains. Above all, don't miss "Step Into the Void" with its glass box at 3842m, the tallest attraction in Europe. 1000m of emptiness beneath your feet, guaranteed thrills!
